JOB PURPOSE:

The refinishing engineer is to treat, prepare, prime and colour aircraft and/or components during maintenance, liaising with the completions supervisor/ licenced engineer. Complementing Completions Centre undertake new activities. He or she may also be required to take control of section.

MAIN RESPONSIBILITIES AND DUTIES:

- Carrying out paint rectification defects inclusive of Treatment, preparation, prime and colour of aircraft and/ or components as directed by the supervisor and licensed engineer.
- Carrying out the re-sealing of panels removed during maintenance
- Carrying out polishing of painted surfaces/ bright-work/ interior parts
- Complement the completions centre during internal and external projects
- Ensuring good house-keeping within the workshop and hangar environment. Paying particular attention to his/ her designated work area.
- Ensuring all activities are carried out in accordance with relevant company and health and safety procedures.
- The organisation and control of labour within his/ her area of responsibility in conjunction with completions supervisor.
- Ensuring specific tools and workshop equipment are maintained and available reporting any findings to supervisor.
- Ensures all activities are carried out in a mindful, efficient, safe and clean fashion.
- Utilising PPE at appropriate times.
- Communicating progress and stock levels on a daily basis. Liaising with supervisors on any issues that could impact safety or job completion dates.
- Constantly seek improvement in all activities to maximise productivity and quality.
- Accepts to travel whenever necessary for training or to support customers/ maintenance projects
- Additional tasks as requested by supervisor.
- He or she will display themselves in company uniform at all times.
